4. A 20kg sled is pulled 36m across a horizontal surface at a constant 2.0m/s. The pulling force has a magnitude of 80N and is directed at an angle of  $30^{\circ}$  above the horizontal. The power generated by the pulling force is?
5. A 342kg motorcycle and rider pass over the top of a hill at 22m/s. The hill has a radius curvature of 120m. Calculate the normal force acting on the bike at the top of the hill.
6. A 350kg sailboat has an acceleration of  $0.62\text{m/s}^2$  at an angle of  $64^{\circ}$  north of east. Find the magnitude and direction of the net force that acts on the sailboat.
